New User - How to build out the best version of you - with an NTM SeeMe Portfolio

You can take as long as required to complete your profile however, you will find that you will be timed out if left unused for too long and then you will need to follow the instructions for Existing Users Below - to finish completing your profile and obviously for continued updating of your lifelong portfolio.

This time out is a security setting to stop anyone having access to your profile should you leave your profile open on a laptop/PC or phone.

Click on the Hobbies that you take part in the scrolling box and they will appear in your list – put a short intro to them in the box below. Click the yellow arrow again and then you will be taken to the Interests screen where you tick the images that attract you or are interested in. Once you have saved this you will then go to the next key step – seeing the Natural Talents that you have unlocked from your selections. - > Social media is OK to use but be careful if you use it for personal interaction as this may not be suitable to share in your portfolio for all to see.
- > Photos should always be the window to who you are so be careful what photo you use smile and be natural or capture you when doing one of your hobbies.
- ➤ Hobbies are those that you do on a regular basis and if it is something that is not in the list you can click on the add a new hobby button and we will get it set up for you.
- ➢ If you do not have many or any hobbies do not worry, this is a point in time and as you grow and develop, you will start to add new hobbies which you can do at any time.
- Interests are visual as they are things that you see and enjoy seeing but do not just tick lots of pictures, really focus on those that create a real emotion or feeling when you look at them.
- ➤ IMPORTANT: There are no right, or wrong answers and you do not have to get everything ticked first time remember that this is something that will help you to see your Dominant Talents, which will change over time, the more things you do and get involved in. This is about creating your SeeMe Portfolio to showcase your true potential to others!

Step 2 – Understanding and Explaining your Talents

Initially Approx. 20 – 30 minutes to complete.

- Your Talents have been uncovered because of the hobbies and interests that you have selected.
- You now need to think about why those talents reflect you, how you apply them and use them in your day-to-day routines, hobbies, and activities. Write a short description in each Talent so that they become visible on your profile.

Once you have completed this stage, you can then send a link to your profile to apply for a role, showcase to others but there is lots more still to do.

To send a link:

- Now you need to click on the button -
 - Send Profile to an Employer (this could also be a friend or family member for them to review your profile)
 - o Follow the 3 steps:
 - O Step 1 -You will only have one version to select at this stage.
 - Step 2 you can choose to send an email or create a link.
 - Step 3 if you send via email fill in the details or
 - If you create a link you will then get a URL to copy

This step can be completed by you on your own or you can now start to develop this with a coach, mentor, careers advisor, support team or friends and family.

You now have a profile that identifies your Natural Talents – you can print your word cloud which shows the potential that you have, keep it safe to remind you the skills you have.

*To print your word cloud – click on the button – view my profile and then scroll down to the print button.

remember	 These are your dominant talents that have been unlocked due to the choices of hobbies and interests that you have selected today but these may change over time as you find new hobbies to get involved with. This list is based on the most frequently selected talents from your selections and ranked as your top 10 for the most times they have come up. It may not be obvious to you, as to why these talents have come up and it is sometimes good to chat with someone else to look at your previous selections as these are a good indicator. Talents are the natural day to day ways that you perform tasks, and you may not 	
	always recognise or see that you have and can be surprising. Do not worry if you really do not know what to write – think about it and discuss with others or drop NTM an email and we can try to help. You will need to put some information against each of your talents so that they then show on your profile, but take you time – as mentioned, there are no right or wrong answers, this is all about developing and showcasing you.	
Step 3 – Building your Portfolio through visual evidence	This can take up to an hour or more to complete if you want to start to build a rich visual portfolio and a video. It can be completed as an initial demonstration of you, but it is advisable to spend as much time as you can so that a future employer or opportunity really gets to see the potential that you have. O If you have clicked the yellow arrow from step 2 then you will be taken to this next step. O If you have saved and are now coming back to this – you will need to refer to Step 3 in the Existing User details below. This will allow you to create a video directly from the screen or you can start to upload documents such as a CV or achievement awards etc. You can also upload pictures as evidence of your hobbies e.g., pictures of cakes you bake, team pictures and more. If you are unable to launch the video from your desktop you can also create your video using your phone and then upload or post on YouTube with a link on the page.	This is the fun part where you can now spend as much or as little time on developing a visual image of you. We suggest that you at least provide some evidence of your hobbies/interests and if possible, a short video to introduce yourself and tell people abit about who you are and what you like doing. This is something that you should continue to develop – adding in achievements, awards, success stories and any development work that you do including actual learning or work experience, volunteering and more
Key Points to remember	 Developing your SeeMe Profile is the key to how you are seen and discovered as people get to see the real you, the potential that you have and the talents that demonstrate those natural abilities that many employers are looking for. Include as many pieces as possible of evidence that showcase your hobbies and the activities that you do, which may include an award for best player or even a local competition where you were recognised for the work that you did and so

This is about providing more detail, which you may not have at this time or depending on your experience, you may have lots of information on. Take as little or as much time needed – you can always go back and add more – which is what you will be doing with this lifelong Portfolio of you. Click the yellow arrow once more and you will go to: Edit My Learning – this is all about how you learn and what you have learnt. This does not have to be academic learning but things that you may have learnt yourself – such as: I taught myself to cook or play an instrument. Edit My Experiences – This does not have to be job specific – it could be volunteering or being a prefect at school or captain of the rugby team – all demonstrations of your talents. Edit My Introduction Text – this is your personal statement, which can be a difficult task to do but use all the SeeMe portfolio to craft a picture of who you are in words. Once you have completed all the screens that you can or have time for – Save and submit your profile from the last screen – my introduction – this will then take you to your dashboard where there are additional fields that you can customise to reflect you including changing your profile colour – see the Dashboard and additional/optional applications below in Existing Users details	or you can use this to work with others such as friends, family, careers advisors, mentors, coaches, and carers to start to build a view of all the things that you have done or are doing. Do not think of this as being about qualifications but about the qualities that you have and how you use them to do lots of different things. Helping at a charity event or teaching or helping someone else is a great talent and should be showcased in your SeeMe portfolio, so people can really see the true you.
